

THE KALAHARI SAFARI 6-NIGHT/7-DAY SAFARI

This safari offers an insight into the culture and history of the Kalahari's oldest inhabitants. It is ideal for the adventure enthusiast offering breathtaking scenery, desert wildlife and the privilege of an introduction to the traditional lifestyle of the San Bushmen



HIGHLIGHTS:

- 4x nights Full board Central Kalahari Game Reserve
- 1x night B&B at a comfortable lodge in Maun
- Bushman Experience
- Starting in Maun – Ending in Maun

Please note: excluding 1 night hotel in Maun on the day of arrival plus transfers.

Day 1: Hainaveld - Bushman Experience, camping

The safari begins in Maun, where your guide will meet you at 07h30 at a pre-arranged meeting point. You will travel 170km to a game farm on the northern border of the **Central Kalahari Game reserve**, set up camp and have a safari briefing. In the afternoon you will participate in a nature walk led by local Bushmen trackers. They will share their intricate bush knowledge and give you an insight into their unique and intriguing culture. (L, D)

Day 1: Maun – Game Farm in **Hainaveld area** (northern border CKGR): 180km, 4h

Days 2-5: Central Kalahari Game Reserve, camping

You will wake up as the sun rises and enter the pristine wilderness of the largest game reserve in Botswana. (45km) The next four days will be exploring the undeveloped wilderness of the northern region of the Kalahari, moving from camp to camp. You will visit **Passarge Valley** (Day 2 and 3) and **Deception Valley** (Day 4 & 5) in your exploration of the Kalahari. Savour the vast open spaces, clear night skies and uninterrupted beauty on game drives and at camp. This is adventure camping in its purest form as water and communications are limited and we travel as a self-sufficient group. Camping is in a designated campsite with fixed/bush ablutions. (B, L, D)

Day 2: Game Farm in Hainaveld area – Central Kalahari Game Reserve: 120km, 4-5h (including game drive)

Days 3-5: Extended game drives

Day 6: Maun, comfortable lodge

After our final morning game drive in the Kalahari we return to **Maun** where our last night will be enjoyed in the comfort of a lodge. Dinner is at your own expense at the lodge. The safari officially ends at 08h00 on Day 7. Bush Ways can assist with your onward travel arrangements. (B, L)

Deception Valley, Central Kalahari – Maun: 340km, 5-6h

LOW SEASON November – June € 1.255,- p.p.

HIGH SEASON July – October € 1.255,- p.p.

Price includes:

All accommodation (spacious bow tents with mattresses)
1 night at a comfortable lodge in Maun
All transfers and activities as per the itinerary

Does not include:

1x diner Maun
Drinks (alcohol, soft drinks and bottled mineral water to be purchased the day before departure)
1x airport transfer accommodation to Maun Airport on the last day

International flights, visas, airport transfers, tips, curios, optional excursions (scenic flight over the Delta and activities in Livingstone/Victoria Falls), Insurance to cover for cancellation and curtailment, medical, baggage, emergency evacuation, any increase in National Park Fees.

General information:

Safari character: Adventurous
Minimum group size: 1 person
Maximum group size: 12 persons
Group: international

Semi participation: All we ask you to do on your safari is carry your own luggage to/from your tent and to put up/take down your own 'user-friendly' tent. The safari team will take care of all other camp chores and food preparation – just sit back and relax and enjoy the sounds of the bush!

Luggage restrictions: 12 kilo - max. size = 700mm x 350mm x 350mm (no hard suitcases) + hand luggage, due to restricted space in the vehicle and trailer or Mokore canoe. Any extra luggage must be left behind and stored. For the storage of luggage in Maun or Livingstone at the start/end of your safari extra costs could be charged.

Drinks: Drinks (mineral water, softs and alcohol) are not included on all our camping safaris and are to be bought the day prior if your safari leaves early on day 1 or on the day if your safari starts at 13h00. A minimum 3 litres of drinking water is recommended per person per day. At all hotel/lodge accommodation drinks are on a cash bar basis.

Meals: You will enjoy a wide variety of meals during your safari and we attempt to include an 'African' flavor in our safari menus. All meals are cooked on an open fire. Special diets on request.

Children: min. age of 12 years

Single supplement: Please note that there is a single supplement charge for single travelers. However, if a single guest is willing to share a tent/room with another single guest of the same gender there is no single supplement charge.
